OPERATIONAL INSTRUCTION

Ordering Of Pilots and Tugs

To all Port Operators, Owners, Masters and Agents of Vessels

To ensure the timely departure of vessels from King Abdullah Port, from the 1st April 2014 the master of the vessel, through his designated agent will be responsible for ordering the services of a pilot and tugs.

Vessels alongside are required to give a minimum of two hours notice for the services of a pilot and tugs. Requests more three hours before the estimated time of departure will not be accepted.

No guarantee of a pilot or tugs will be given unless adequate notice has been provided, however in the event of a late request every attempt will be made to provide a pilot and tugs at the expected departure time, if the situation allows.

Should the pilot arrive on board the vessel at the agreed order time and the vessel is not ready for sea in all respects a detention charge will be applied in accordance with the published tariff.
